

Dear Parents

St David's Parish wishes to invite your child/children to commence their journey for the Sacraments of Reconciliation, Confirmation and First Communion.

Parents are the first and most important models of lived faith for children. Therefore, it is vital that you take an active role in the preparation of your children for the Sacraments as part of their personal Catholic Commitment. Their preparation is assisted through participation in and attendance at the Sacramental meetings for each sacrament they will be receiving and by being involved in the parish community, especially at Mass.

Parish Schools are the teachers of the Sacraments and Parishes have the responsibility of ensuring that a process is in place which enables children and their families to access a programme of formation prior to celebrating the individual sacraments.
